Skill Development: To enhance the students' culinary skills by allowing them to plan, prepare, and present a variety of dishes.



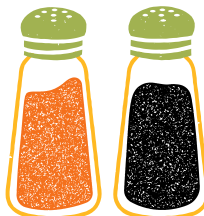
