MD. Fauji Foundation, MD Mari Energies and MD Fauji Fertilizers



On February 25, 2025, a distinguished delegation from the Fauji Foundation, led by Lt. Gen (Retd) Anwer Ali Hyder, along with Mr. Faheem Haider, MD of Mari Energies, and Mr. Jahangir Piracha, MD of Fauji Fertilizers, visited Noor-e-Sehar Special Education School.
